ENROLLMENT FEE* – \$250.00 non-refundable. Each student entering the school is required to pay a \$250.00 Enrollment Fee (EF). A billing statement for the EF will be enclosed with the letter of admission. Payment by the student confirms acceptance of admission and reserves a place for the student in the entering class. The EF is applied to the required drug screening. The \$250.00 EF is refundable if the student cancels his/her admission ninety (90) days prior to the beginning of the academic semester to which the student has been admitted. After ninety (90) days, there is no refund.

Other Related Expenses

Textbooks and Required Resources – First Level Nursing students spend an average of about \$1,040 (depending on print or e-book preference) on the first Level Nursing Bundle and an average of about \$750 in science and General Education books. Second Level Nursing students purchase their remaining Nursing book bundle when they begin second Level Nursing courses with an average of about \$440. Students spend on average about \$200 per semester for remaining terms for General Education textbooks.
